Our positive, welcoming environment helps women and their families build healthier futures through our holistic approach to care.

We provide gender-focused, trauma-informed, culturally safe care. In addition to health services, we are able to connect patients to community-based supports like those offered by our sister society, EFry, which include shelters & housing, substance use recovery, life skills, and child & youth programs.

If you are interested in joining an integrated care team, where you will be supported in operating at the top of your license while helping vulnerable women and children enjoy healthier lives and futures, we invite your application.

**We are recruiting for a Registered Nurse (RN)** to join a shared care practice in a team-based healthcare environment with fully integrated health services driven by quality improvement. The RN performs a critical role in an interdisciplinary team from triaging patients and directing them to appropriate care, to assessing and managing patients' presenting issues, within the level of the RN scope whether independently or in consultation with other team members. The RN will have the required skills to assist other team members in the event of a medical emergency requiring stabilization while awaiting transfer to higher levels of care. It is the goal of the organization to ensure all patients feel safe, valued, respected, and cared for as they access health care services. The RN will be tasked to demonstrate improved access to primary

care and quality of primary care for our population of vulnerable women and children. Due to extended hours of operation that may be needed, the RN must be willing to participate in evening and weekend hours at times.

### **Scope of Practice**

The RN will provide full- scope of services that would be commensurate with the breadth and depth of professional services provided by a full-time full-service, RN, for the care of its patients and the health of the community within which it practices. The RN will also support and provide clinically related teaching and clinically related research.

### **Qualifications**

- Completion of a recognized Registered Nurse education program
- Current practicing registration as a Registered Nurse with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM)
- Significant nursing experience (minimum two years) with recent and related work in a variety of settings including primary care, emergency department, or remote settings.
- Current CPR-HCP Certification essential
- Experience working with marginalized populations (mental health and addictions, poverty, vulnerable youth, Indigenous, refugee, LGBTQ2I+, and other community members)
- Completion of the Point of Care HIV Testing course and successful completion of the BCCDC Immunization certificate and Narcan Certification and/or commitment to complete within six (6) months of hire.

EFry Health Centre is an equity-seeking organization. Applications are encouraged from qualified women, Indigenous, Black, People of Colour, LGBTQ2S+ individuals, people with disabilities and other marginalized groups.
